- The orchestra is open to all classical guitarists of age 16 and above.
- Modest sight-reading ability is required as well as an ability to commitment to learn the assigned parts.
- A small materials fee may be charged on the first session.
- Sessions dates: **January 14 through May 20 (18 weeks)** and will take place at the Longay Conservatory of Guitar auditorium on **Thursday evenings** from **7:00 – 8:00 pm.** (no class April 8)
- The sessions are subject to enrollment. There are no refunds except in the event of the cancellation of the course.
- The director of the orchestra will be masters Eastman graduate, Robert Miller. Information about Mr. Miller is available from our web-site.
- Fee for your participation in the orchestra is \$150 and is due with your registration form by the date below.
